Morinville resident wins Persons Case scholarship

Morinville resident Doveina Bolen recently won a \$2,500 scholarship for the 2021-2022 Persons Case Scholarship.

The provincial government scholarship supports the achievements of Alberta students by making their post-secondary education more accessible.

As part of the application, Bolen was required to share her experiences and aspirations. Applicants were also asked what they are doing to advance gender equality and improve women's lives in Alberta and beyond.

Bolen noted she applied for the scholarship to help represent people considered minorities in the Canadian population.

For example, her research revealed that only 20 percent of people in policing

are women. Policing is Bolen's preferred career.

"The scholarship is about under represented people from different backgrounds and cultures, including the LGBTQ2 community," said Bolen.

"They [police agencies] are looking for more women. That's what inspired me to apply and to help further my career so I can help make a difference."

Bolen recently completed year one of the

two-year Police Studies program at MacEwan University so she can join the RCMP.

The scholarship includes a cheque for \$2,500 for each of the 40 winners. The scholarship is funded by the Government of Alberta Ministry of Culture and Status of Women.

Bolen learned that her scholarship application was successful when she checked her email on April 1.

"I was going for a class at university and checked my email, and I saw it, and I went wow!" said Bolen.

She's grateful to a couple of mentors who provided references for the application, including a retired police officer and a Taekwondo instructor.

After Bolen graduates from the Police Studies program, she plans to begin the recruiting process to join the RCMP.



Travis follows and admires many athletes and teams, but he has his favourites like most fans. His number one sport is hockey.

The Dallas Stars are his first-choice team, and Mike Modano is his hockey idol.Interesting choices for a smalltown Alberta boy.

Travis can't remember a time when he wasn't a sports enthusiast. When asked, he said he felt like he was born with a hockey stick in his hand.

Travis comes from a long line of hockey players. When he was younger, his dad was quite the goalie, both of his grandfathers played, even his Grandma Fraser was on a hockey team.

Travis has an impressive assortment of coveted sports gear, including over 250 hockey jerseys, about 100 football jerseys, half a dozen baseball jerseys, and 50 hockey sticks

from over the years.

Travis still has his old hockey sticker albums, which harbour many cherished memories.

Over the decades, Travis has numerous inspiring memories connected to his passion for sports.

One of Travis' most unforgettable experiences was when his brother, Ben, surprised him with a plane ticket to Dallas to see Mike Modano's jersey retirement.

He spent the weekend there and watched his hockey idol be honoured by the fans. Also, there have been several road trips over the years to witness various sporting events.

Travis, and his wife Melissa, have even been to two San Francisco 49er games. One was in Minnesota, and the other was in San Francisco, where they tailgated and witnessed Gerry Rice's jersey retirement. Two - \$2000 awards are available for Sturgeon County residents enrolled in a recognized post-secondary institution along with demonstrated involvement in the Sturgeon County community.


To be considered, you must be a current resident of Sturgeon County, but may be living temporarily outside of Sturgeon County for your schooling.

COMMUNITY NOTICE

ANNUAL VEGETATION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

Every year, CN is required to clear its right-of-way of any vegetation that may pose a safety hazard. Vegetation on railway right-of-way, if left uncontrolled, can contribute to trackside fires and impair proper inspection of track infrastructure.

For safe railway operations, CN will conduct its annual vegetation control program on its rail lines in the province of Alberta. A certified professional will be applying herbicides on and around the railway tracks (primarily along the 16 – 24 feet graveled area/ ballast). All product requirements for setbacks in the vicinity of dwellings, aquatic environments, and municipal water supplies will be met.
