More than 300 people gathered at the Morinville Community Cultural Centre on May 14 to enjoy a variety show while supporting a fundraiser.

The St. Jean Baptiste Rebuild FUNdraiser Extravaganza was a high-energy evening intended to raise funds to rebuild the historic St. Jean Baptiste Catholic Church.

"We want to hear the bells ring again," said Denise Touchette, a volunteer on the fundraising committee.

"All of the fundraising from this event goes to the bells and the steeple as part of the reconstruction. The church is very important for us, and we're looking to rebuild the whole thing."

The 8-member fundraising community thanked

everybody who made the event possible and promised the bells would ring again.

Dignitaries included Bishop Paul Terrio, St. Paul Diocese, Father Trini and Father Lester of the St. Jean Baptiste Parish.

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

for the past year, is impressed with Critchley's dedication to Bon Accord. "She's been a phenomenal help to our organization and supporting youth in sports in the community," said Brown. "I can't say enough."

"We were struggling to find

words," said Brown. "How are there words to express when you have a volunteer who committed hours and hours and over 50 years of community service?"

Gail Critchley began her journey of volunteering in 1970 when she coached the local girls' ball team. A few years later, she coached her two son's sports teams. "I was always in sports," said Critchley. She got involved in

the local sports committee, helped the community league, and worked with the Bon Accord Recreation Board. "Way back in the day, they had to have a recreation board to build the arenas," said Critchley.

"The recreation board through the town was a volunteer from each one of the community groups. So it was from community league as the volunteer itself." She continued to stay active in sports and described playing hockey as

her favourite team activity.

Critchley offered some advice to residents: "Get involved in the community because you are the community," she said.

"If you haven't volunteered, don't complain. Volunteering is one way of meeting a wonderful group of people, every year, there's a new group, and it's just awesome."

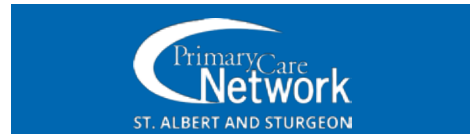
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Morinville RCMP respond to serious collision on Hwy 28

Morinville RCMP, along with the Military Police from the Edmonton Garrison and Emergency Medical Services responded to a two vehicle collision on Hwy 28 at the intersection of Sturgeon Road, Township Road 544.

At 6:00 p.m. on May 23, 2022 the Morinville RCMP received a report that a northbound travelling SUV made u-turn and collided head on with a northbound travelling motorcycle.

The collision took place at the intersection of Hwy 28 and Township Road 544.

As a result of the collision the one occupant of the motorcycle was transported by ambulance to an Edmonton area hospital with life threatening injuries. The driver of the SUV is detained by police for further investigation.

The RCMP collision reconstructionist were on scene. Preliminary investigation suggests that driving impairment may be a contributor this head on collision.
