# Fifty years in business for Namao Auto & RV Repair

In 1962 the founder of Namao Auto & RV Repair, Ted Suranyi, was enrolled in the Alberta Apprenticeship Program with a goal of becoming an Automotive Service Technician (known then as "Motor Vehicle Mechanic"). Having always enjoyed working with hands and tinkering with vehicles, Ted spent his apprenticeship years working for Master Motors Services Co. which was located on 97st and 118 ave in Edmonton. As luck would have it for Ted, just down the road from where he was working, a big brand new school was

being built with the vision an Edmonton-based institute for apprenticeship and vocational training.

This school was to be named the Northern Alberta Institute of Technology and Ted would become part of one of the first graduating classes from NAIT under their Motor Vehicle Mechanic trade.

Ted continued to work for

very young boys at the time, ranging from 5-8 years old.

As you can imagine, this was no small risk, but Ted saw the opportunity and knew that the Namao area could benefit from having a local automotive and truck repair shop.

Ted and Deanna were living on an acreage in Carbondale at the time, (only 5 min from Namao) so it was decided that this was the best place to build a small 3 bay facility. the business so the original entity included a storage lot in the field next to the building. (BTW – Ted still resides on the original Carbondale acreage, as did Deanna until her passing in 2021.)

Now that a dream was in motion and a plan was in place, all that was needed was a name... Taking a practical approach of combining the first letters of their names and a description of what they were going to be doing, seemed like a good idea.... as such, in September of 1972....

Construction is scheduled to begin in 2023 and be operational in 2024.


