The newly constructed École Citadelle is scheduled to open in September and will host approximately 250 students in Grades 4 to 9.

According to Principal Lisa Magera, the new design has the school divided by the gym in the middle, with elementary classes on one side and junior high classes on the other.

"The traffic flow should be much easier than the building we're in right now," said Magera. The layout will be useful for student gatherings for announcements, award ceremonies and other students.

"The centre of the school will be very much a hub for activities," said Magera.

"One of the other cool things we're hoping to have is a cafeteria space where kids can eat because we have a nice serving area. So that'll be a plus for junior high students and parents."

The school offers a few unique experiences: full-time kindergarten, free bussing and a hockey academy for participating students in Grades 4 to 9.

"They're on the ice at least two hours a week, next door at the arena," said Magera. "It's at a very reasonable cost because we don't need to have any bussing." École Citadelle will also work with Legal School on the outdoor playground. talks with Legal School to see how we can do something together for both of our schools," said Magera.

She added the plan is to have two outdoor basketball courts open in September.

The new École Citadelle will have room for preschool, a wood workshop, and a team that looks forward to meeting students and their parents. "We have a very dynamic, enthusiastic staff, and we're hoping to grow our numbers," said Magera. "We're looking for

After 25 years of teaching music to Morinville residents, Smith Music has pivoted into serving corporations and municipalities such as Smith Media and Consulting. June 30 was the last day of Smith Music which focused on teaching, recording and supporting live shows.

"During COVID, our live production portion of our business was affected, so we pivoted that, and our recording studio, into content creation for businesses and municipalities," said Smith.

"I'm humbled at how responsive people have been, which made me get so busy."

"I'vealwaysthought I would teach until nobody wants to listen to me anymore," he laughed. "The business was fine, and it was making money; it's just that I couldn't do everything."

After he posted that message on his Facebook page, Smith was astonished at the positive response from the community.

"I put a video together on May 9, and the stories I love from the community have blown me away. This is the hardest decision I've ever made from a business perspective because I love teaching."

His new role will include new opportunities for creating music.

"For example, I create all original music for content that I make, which is kind of a unique business position for content creation," said Smith. As for his music teaching business, he's handing that over to trusted and experienced tutors who love what they do.

"I decided to give that to my teachers so they could continue on, and the students could have that reliability. It just felt like the right thing to do," he said.

Smith noted that if he's contacted by people who want musical tutorials, he will give referrals to local instructors with teaching businesses. "Teaching for finished June 29," he said. "I hope that somebody better than myself will come along, and if I don't make room for them, then it's not going to happen. My belief as a teacher was that I was only successful if
