

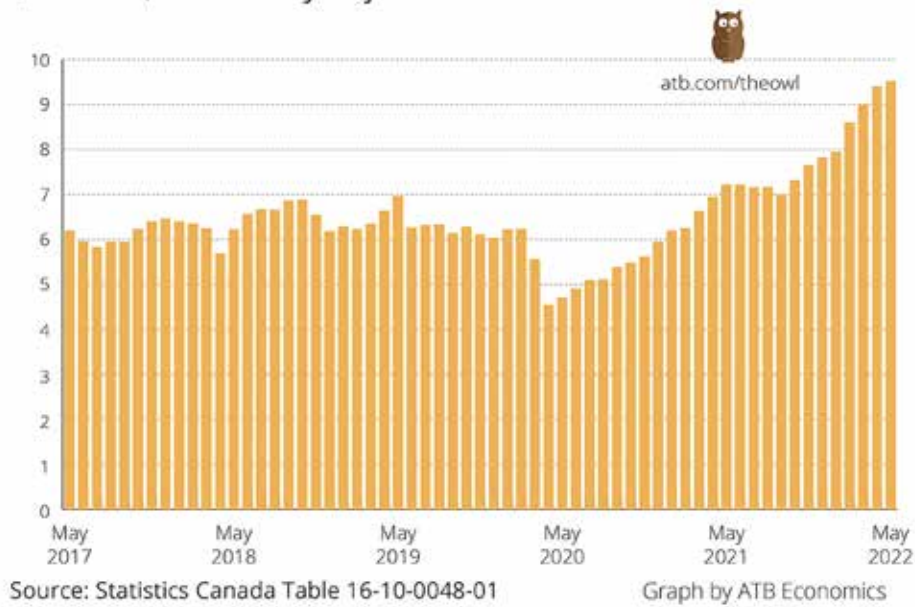

Monthly manufacturing sales in Alberta \$ billions, seasonally adjusted



No slowing down for Alberta's manufacturing activity

Revenues from factory sales in Alberta picked up for the eighth straight month in May.

Supported by increases in durable and non-durable industries, the value of seasonally-adjusted manufacturing shipments posted a monthly increase of \$109 million (+1.2%) to reach \$9.5 billion in May.

Driven in part by the ongoing shortage of computer chips, national manufacturing sales fell 2.0% in May.

So far this year, the refined

petroleum and coal products category has posted the strongest growth in both Alberta and in the country as a whole.

Through the first five months of the year, the rise in refined petroleum and coal product sales accounted for 60% of the total increase in manufacturing shipments in Alberta and 34% nationally.

Higher prices were the main factor with the dollar value of refined petroleum and coal product sales in Canada up by 81% while the implied volume of shipments increased by 15%.

The impact of soaring prices was also seen in other parts of the manufacturing sector including food products and chemicals.

Morinville's multi-family residential tax rate hike policy gets rough ride

Several Morinville councillors voiced concern about a draft policy containing a statement indicating support for creating a new assessment sub-classification for multi-family residential in which the tax rate would progress annually until it was 20% higher than all other residential property in Morinville by 2026.

Town council pulled the taxation section out of a draft policy on budget principles on July 12, then directed administration to bring forward a separate policy on taxation guidelines.

The taxation section also indicated an intent to continue to increase commercial and industrial property taxation rates to reach 50% higher than the residential tax rate, while creating a new assessment sub-classification for small business which would have a tax rate 15% lower than that of other commercial property. (Qualifying small businesses would end up paying 27.5%

higher than the residential tax rate).

If this sounds more confusing than clarifying you could be a councillor, because the discussion at the council meeting evolved to the same conclusion.

Coun. Rebecca Balanko questioned the criteria for multi-family – whether it would involve a property with more than three families rather than a basement suite in a family residence triggering the higher tax rate.

Administration advised the criteria doesn't exist and would be created by council through bylaw.

Administration also indicated the rationale for the sub-classification is that apartment buildings are somewhat similar to businesses because they generate a profit for the owner, so the new sub-classification would increase the tax rate higher than other residential but still lower than the business tax rates.

Coun. Scott Richardson told council that to be

comfortable with the policy statement he would have to see the definition of multi-family and see some figures resulting from the new sub-classification.

Administration advised that those would come at the decision point – which would be when council considers a bylaw enacting the sub-classification.

Both Richardson and coun. Ray White questioned where the tax rate target for multi-family would put the town compared to other municipalities, with White questioning whether there could be a negative impact on development of multi-family projects as a result of the tax category.

Richardson also questioned the practicality of defining a small business for the purpose of the discounted commercial tax rate, suggesting it may be better to continue to treat all businesses the same and lower the final target rate for business to 145% of the residential tax rate rather than creating a new business

sub-classification at the larger discount.

Coun. Jenn Anheliger concluded that the taxation section should be removed from what was on the agenda as a 'Budget Principles and Guidelines Policy.'

Council agreed and after passing her resolution directing administration to prepare the stated policy without the taxation section a second motion directing administration to draft a taxation principles and guidelines policy was passed.

Coun. Maurice St. Denis

questioned the process of putting a new assessment sub-classification target into a draft policy and then telling concerned residents who learn of the higher tax rate that it isn't in effect unless it is included in a bylaw.

There was no formal public consultation regarding the multi-family sub-classification and none has been scheduled yet, however residents and taxpayers can contact council members through the town website to make their views known on any issue.

Are you looking for something fun and exciting to do with your neighbours this summer?

The Town of Morinville offers step-by-step information on hosting your own block party.

The town states, "Block Parties are a great way to celebrate you and your neighbours and build a strong sense of community, connectedness, and a culture of care."

Knowing your neighbours is a great way to increase neighbourhood pride and safety and build supports and networks."

Download the "Hosting a Block Party document" and "Block Party Checklist." Then recruit neighbours on your street to help with planning, choosing the location, date and time. Don't forget to pick the type of block party you would like to host.

A few examples could be barbecue, potluck, or an activity night. Three weeks ahead, you can fill out the "Block Party Application Form" and Neighbourhood Support Form."

The first four applications approved will receive a \$75 gift card from Sobeys.

Two weeks prior, you can put up posters of the event and

invite all on your block, don't forget to notify everyone of any traffic disruptions.

One week prior is the time to pick up any food and supplies or check in on what others are bringing.

The day of your block party is for the setup and fun!

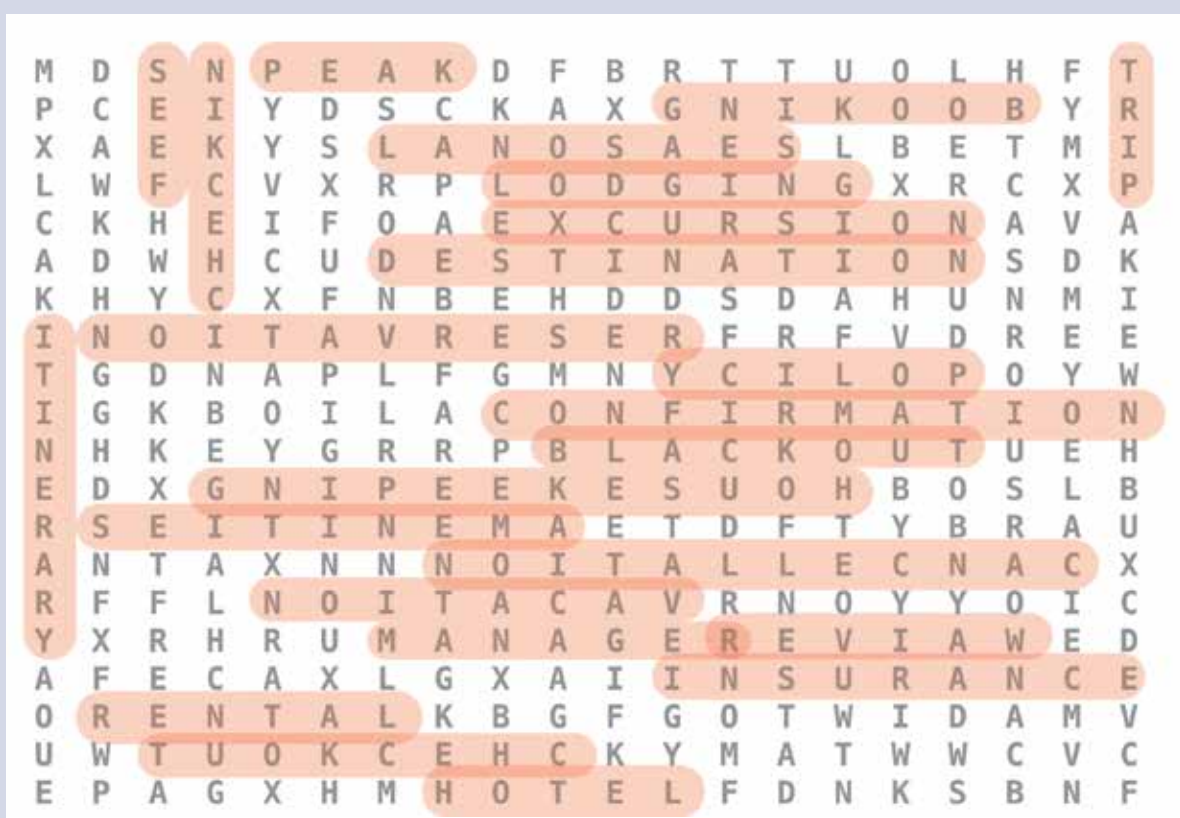


