
**PUBLIC HEARING - 1598/22** Amendment to Land Use Bylaw 1385/17

In accordance with section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, Sturgeon County Council is requesting public input on proposed Bylaw 1598/22. This Bylaw proposes to amend the Land Use Bylaw by amending the land use district of Lot A Plan 7821276 from AG -Agriculture to RVS - Recreational Vehicle Storage.


### Red lights flashing? No passing!
