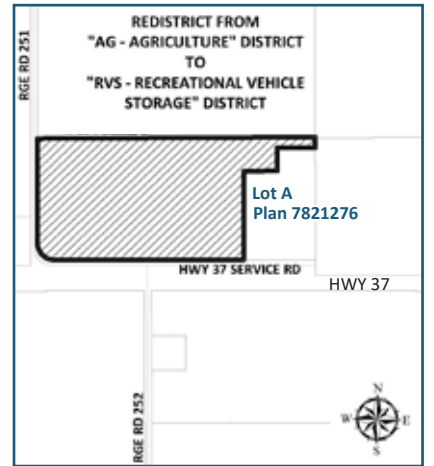

In accordance with section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, Sturgeon County Council is requesting public input on proposed Bylaw 1598/22. This Bylaw proposes to amend the Land Use Bylaw by amending the land use district of Lot A Plan 7821276 from AG – Agriculture to RVS – Recreational Vehicle Storage.
