



2022 second quarter air quality monitoring results released

Fort Air Partnership (FAP), the organization that monitors the air local residents breathe, released 2022 second quarterAir Quality Health Index (AQHI) resultstoday.

The Government of Alberta calculates the AQHI using data collected at seven of FAP's air monitoring stations.

Results show that AQHI in the Airshed was of low risk to health at least 98% of the time for April, May, and June.

There were zero hours of high or very high AQHI rating for the calendar quarter. Risk to health increases as the index level rises. In comparing the 2022 second-quarter results to the 2021 second-quarter results, there were fewer moderate risk level hours in 2022 than in 2021 (102 in 2022 compared to 153 in 2021). There was only one hour of high AQHI rating for the second quarter in 2021 compared to zero in 2022.

The forecasted and daily Alberta Health Quality Index for the Fort Air





The Morinville Community Library is located at 10125-100 Avenue and is an essential staple in town. They focus on bringing everyone together, whether with early literacy, diverse clubs for all ages, or enjoying a good book.

Throughout the year, the library hosts many free programs starting with the 1000 books program, which encourages parents to begin reading to their children in the early years before pre-k. It is to help the child get ready for school and the learning process.

The library offers a log for parents to fill out as they read, every milestone that is hit (100, 200, etc.), your photo is taken and put up on display in the kid's area, and you can receive a sponsored graduation and reward.

Cozy Corner Stories and Crafts is offered to younger children at the library every Thursday morning. Stories are read and include a take-home craft bag following the theme of the story.

Isabelle Cramp, Library Director, said, "Our programs help prepare kids with early literacy, having the experience of sitting down reading and rhyming and participating in a school-like setting."

Offered to the older children are summer and winter reading programs which kids are then split into teams where they can compete and accumulate their reading minutes and earn rewards.

Animanga and Minecraft clubs are fully supervised by staff and allow teens and young adults to chat in groups with people with the same interests in games or their favourite anime shows.

The library has adult clubs, including quilting, spinning/knitting, and a book club.

Adults of all ages can look forward to trying something new with the discovery and creativity bags, which bring awareness and find new skills. Or ask the staff to try "spice it up," which includes all sorts of unique spices and tea.

Something for your family to look forward to this Christmas is the second annual 24 days to Christmas "big bag." This includes a countdown calendar, activities for all to enjoy, new recipes to try, and a QR code that will bring you to a new book the family can sit down and enjoy together.

Cramp stated, "the library is more than just books. You can expect literacy services, public computers with the internet, printing, and photocopying. A library is a place where everyone is welcome and is a safe place for anyone! A place we want to encourage people to come to discover if they haven't been here. People will be amazed by how many resources we have available here. We are very passionate about the community and responsive to hearing feedback. We like to hear what the people need to grow our services to serve the community better."

Bylaw 1597/22 Diversified Agriculture & Events

Council to Consider Potential Second Reading of Bylaw 1597/22 (Diversified Agriculture and Events) in September 2022

On June 14, 2022, Sturgeon County Council held a Public Hearing regarding Bylaw 1597/22. This bylaw encompassed the Agribusiness and Agritourism Review Task Force recommendations and proposed the following amendments to the County's Land Use Bylaw:

- Include Diversified Agriculture within the AG-Agriculture District as a permitted use, and also create a new AG2 – Agriculture 2 District that supports more intensive permitted uses. Diversified Agriculture includes value added ag processing, retail sales of ag products, and allows for commercial experiences and events related to farming or farm life. If approved, operators could seek permits for these uses without the need for neighbour advisement and potential appeal.
- The proposed bylaw also allows for event venues to be located within AG parcels, as a discretionary use. This means that operators could apply to have an event venue, and the permit/conditions would be subject to potential appeal by affected parties.

You can access Bylaw 1597/22 at sturgeoncounty.ca/AgriReview.

The County received significant feedback during the Public Hearing, and we want to ensure Council has sufficient time to review and consider that input fully. Therefore, Council will next be considering the bylaw at the September 13, 2022, Council Meeting.

Given the extent and nature of the feedback received, there is the potential for further amendments to the proposed bylaw when Council considers second reading. Should there be substantive amendments to the bylaw, Sturgeon County would hold an additional public hearing to allow the public to comment on any proposed changes prior to further consideration.

The agenda for the September 13, 2022, Council Meeting will be published closer to the meeting date, and all materials will be publicly available at sturgeoncounty.ca/ CouncilMeetings.
