as I trained to become a teacher in university, I started teaching dance in Morinville as well," Namchuk said. "Through my years of teaching, I ran a Dance Academy program through the local schools in town. This year, it was time to make a change, and I was ready to open my own space and dance studio."

Namchuk said that although she had never felt ready before, that changed this year, and it was time to go for it and achieve her longtime goal. "I never thought I'd be driven enough to do it, and this year was the year—I challenged myself for that."

While Rachelle will lead the operations in terms of dance programming and instruction with the assistance of other dance teachers, husband and business partner Mitchell Namchuk will look after the operations side of the business.

"I'm an assistant on the financial advice and running everything," he said. "I'll be handling the business operations, and we'll

be hiring more for the business operations already."

Movement Dance Studio will focus on Namchuk's expertise in ballet, lyrical, tap, contemporary and modern dance.

"I'm very into contemporary/modern dance," she said, adding her children are becoming obsessed with dance, particularly her six-year-old daughter. "She wants to get into everything. It seems very fitting. Let's do this and open up our own space so I can continue to pass it down to my daughter and my children for the years to come."

Although children will be a large part of the new dance studio's students, lessons are open to all age groups—two to adults.

"We have a musical theatre adult class. We have adult hip-hop, adult lyrical class, and adult tap class," Namchuk said. "We're hoping to eventually open up some offers for seniors. We've had a lot of interest in seniors doing tap dancing, which we'd love to do, and hopefully, it is something we can

make happen as short sessions."

Movement Dance Studio offers full-year programming from September to June with a year-end and Christmas recital for non-adult students.

In addition to the dance classes, they also offer theatrical make-up with an upcoming session focused on wounds and gashes for Halloween.

"[We use] professional theatre makeup. It's really cool, and it's a really unique thing," Namchuk said. "We work with Carrie's costumes. They've been a huge supporter of ours."

Whether dance or makeup, Namchuk said she and partner Mitchell want to emphasize that they are a dance family at Movement Dance Studio and that everyone is welcome.

"We want everyone to be part of something great and feel comfortable and like they belong," Namchuk said.

In accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, Sturgeon County Council is requesting public input on proposed Bylaw 1597/22. This Bylaw proposes to amend the Land Use Bylaw by enacting recommendations of the Agribusiness and Agritourism Review Task Force Recommendations Report including, but not limited to:

- Creation of Event Venue use and related regulations.
- Creation of Diversified Agriculture use and related regulations.
- Amending the AG - Agriculture District to allow Diversified Agriculture as a permitted use.
- Creation of an AG2 - Agriculture 2 District to allow more intensive agricultural uses as permitted uses.
- Allow the gathering of development information to be used to trial an Impact Matrix.
- Other related changes.

Proposed amendments to the Bylaw since the June 14, 2022 Public Hearing include:

- Removing Event Venue use from the AG - Agriculture District.
- Clarification of Diversified Agriculture definition.

Preparing livestock for winter

As the temperature begins to drop and farmers work through the harvesting season, some are preparing for winter by preparing

their livestock. Livestock includes animals like cows, pigs, horses, goats and many more. Farmers have a lot to do before the freezing temperatures hit their farms and have been

busy preplanning what they will do for winter. They must prepare and plan for the basic needs of animals like food, water and shelter. Doing so will keep the animals healthy

through the minus 30 weather and help reduce the number of sick animals and save money.

Ensuring a dependable water supply is an asset; farmers cannot

rely on natural water sources as it will freeze and take days before it thaws. Many farmers use tank heaters or de-icers, which take well-kept maintenance to stay running each year. Some farmers don't use heaters but will insulate all the pipes and faucets.

Some livestock is accustomed to foraging through the warmer months. Therefore, farmers must consider that animals must eat more in the winter to provide extra calories for heat energy. Eating more food also gives to keep warm. Farmers always make a backup plan just in case they must follow through with emergency feeding procedures.

Shelter for livestock will need to be prepared through the fall months, and when the

cooler winds begin to pick up, the shelters are called windbreaks. Windbreaks are set up for the outdoor animals to shelter from the brutal winter winds. Farmers also winterize barns and other shelter buildings. The buildings' roofs are constantly inspected and repaired to withstand the heavy weight of snow through the winter. They also set up heaters and ensure they are properly working and that the sheltered areas have good ventilation.

Farmers check on livestock daily, ensuring their livestock's needs are met and are prepared for any unexpected emergencies they may face through the cold winter months. A farmer's job is never done.

October 1 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Gibbons Cultural Centre (5115 51 Street). Participants do not need a landfill permit for this free event.

"Hazardous Wastes are not accepted at Roseridge yet as a year-round program," said Roseridge Manager Susan Berry,

noting there are plans to accept the materials when their new facility opens. "We ask that residents store their household hazardous waste safely on their property for these events where they can dispose of them and keep them out of the landfill."

Roseridge currently holds a spring and fall event. The

first event of 2022 took place in Morinville this spring, and this fall's event allows the region's residents another opportunity to dispose of their items properly.

"Roseridge has taken on this role from the municipalities to support a regional effort and collaboration," said Roseridge Manager Susan Berry. "Rather than

each of the municipalities duplicating the service and offering it on their own, we're doing it on behalf of the entire region."

Household hazardous waste includes cleaning products, paints, pesticides, and other consumer products with warning labels, as well as used cooking oil.

"If you are unsure, bring

it," Berry said, noting the default should be to bring everything.

In addition to the household hazardous wastes, the event will include an electronics roundup where they will accept anything with a plug, from old hair dryers to television sets.

Berry and the Commission hope for another successful event and encourage the area's residents to come out.

"It's completely free. It's convenient. It's in town. Stop in and bring it, even if you have one or two items," Berry said. "Bring those one or two items and keep them out of the landfill."
