Chamber picks its award winners for this year

The annual Morinville & District Chamber of Commerce Gala took place on Saturday, October 28, at the Morinville Community Cultural Centre with an Around the World theme and the largest roster of nominees in recent history. The Chamber received over 400 individual nominations for 53 businesses in eight categories this

time, plus Youth Entrepreneur and business integrity nominees. But not all of the nominees could walk away with the award. The Ag Business/Farm Family category nominees include Deb's Greenhouse, Bokey Blooms Farms, Rosy Farms, Chuck's Berry Farm, and Birchwood Meadows. Deb's Greenhouse was chosen as this

Other nominees this year included Sturgeon Brewing Company, The Ice Hut, Smokehouse Grills & Purolator, Grass Theory, JLS Decals & Signs, Panchita's Taqueria, Morinville Pizza, Au Chocolat, Legendary Liquor, Black Bar Crossfit, Odin Renovations Inc., Madaflo Craftsman, and Rentz & Rover Pet Services.

Medium business nominees include Coach's Corner Sports Bar & Grill, Celebrations Flare Catering, Ok Tire Morinville, Bistrot Di Madre Piccola, Drayden Insurance Ltd., and Animal Wellness Veterinary Clinic. OK Tire took home the award.

The Large Business category drew three nominations: Sturgeon Cleaning Service, Morinville Shell, and Atlas Premium Home Development with Sturgeon Cleaning Services winning this year.

Community Spirit is open to businesses and non-profit organizations that enhance the community.

Midstream Support Society, who have operated in Morinville for years, won this year. Other nominees included Fusion Thrift Shoppe, Morinville Adopt-A-Family, and Second Chance Animal Rescue Society.

Young entrepreneurs were also recognized at the gala

with Emily's Petdana's, Willow Ralph - Panchita's Taqueria and Movement Dance Studio instructors Elizabeth Nelson, Brooklynn Payne, Kenzie MacRae, Jade Van Lersberghe, Haley Oullette and Grace Dundass, each nominated for the award. Willow Ralph of Panchita's Taqueria was this year's winner.

The Chamber also

has its own Integrity Award, which is selected and voted on by the Chamber. Hunters Print & Copy was chosen as the Integrity Award winner this year.

The Chamber chose to hold the annual event on a Saturday this year, rather than the usual Thursday, to allow more time for networking after the dinner, entertainment and awards.

Communities in Bloom Pioneer Commemorative Project

Kowalski family members, Bon Accord Communities and Bloom (CiB) members and Town of Bon Accord Council and administrator met at the Bon Accord Cemetery to dedicate a plow and sign installation to the pioneers of the region. Many area pioneers are buried in this cemetery.

Kevin Kowalski stated that next year his family will have farmed in this community for 130 years. A donation to CiB made by the Kowalski family, with a caveat to create a lasting tribute to the area pioneers, initiated this project. They suggested something in the cemetery.

Town Council approved the concept and CiB executed the plan. Addition pioneer families added to the fund and a sign was agreed upon. But what to put on the sign? What truly symbolizes the pioneers? Horses, plows, grain and many more ideas were bantered about. The donation of a real plow by Diane Stretch-Stang, granddaughter of John and Katherine Kowalski, rounded out the idea and was quickly added to the plan. CiB built the cement plinth and attached the plow. The sign, designed by CiB and built by Tom Bland of Roughneck Manufacturing, completed the installation.

The Kowalski Family present were Kevin Kowalski, Tammy (Kowalski) McArthur and Diane Stretch-Stang. "We should, as our pioneers, push forward with the



same fortitude that they did," underscores Mayor Brian Holden. "I believe we must honour their legacy by continuing to push forward and build on what they have done for our great town."

MCHS student takes silver in Kung Fu

A 14-year-old Morinville Community High School student has returned from Calgary with a silver medal in her sport. Sturgeon County resident Olivia Laporte competed in the WKU World Championships from Oct. 16 to 23. At that competition, she took her medal in kung fu soft-style forms - Junior Female (Age 13-14).

Laporte had hoped to win gold but is pleased with the win, given some stiff competition.

"I was a little disappointed that I didn't win gold, but the style of the girl I went up against is really tough to beat," Laporte said. "She did Wushu Kung Fu, and that seemed to be a favourite of the judges. There was some really tough competition, and I had to go up against some black belts, but it was a cool experience."

Laporte got into the sport after hearing her father's stories of his

years in karate and her own desire to get into martial arts.

"I looked up the difference between Karate and Kung Fu, and I liked the style of Kung Fu better because of its circular movements," Laporte said. "I like everything about Martial Arts. It teaches discipline, and even if you feel tired, you push yourself to go and feel better after. I feel stronger after each session, and it makes me want to do better."

Laporte trains at the Canadian Ging Wu Martial Arts Association, where the teachers told the students about the WKU National Competition in Calgary last May that they would have to compete to qualify for Team Canada. In total, ten students from the school went. Team Canada was the largest country represented, with more than two hundred athletes in attendance. Canada ranked fourth overall in the competition.

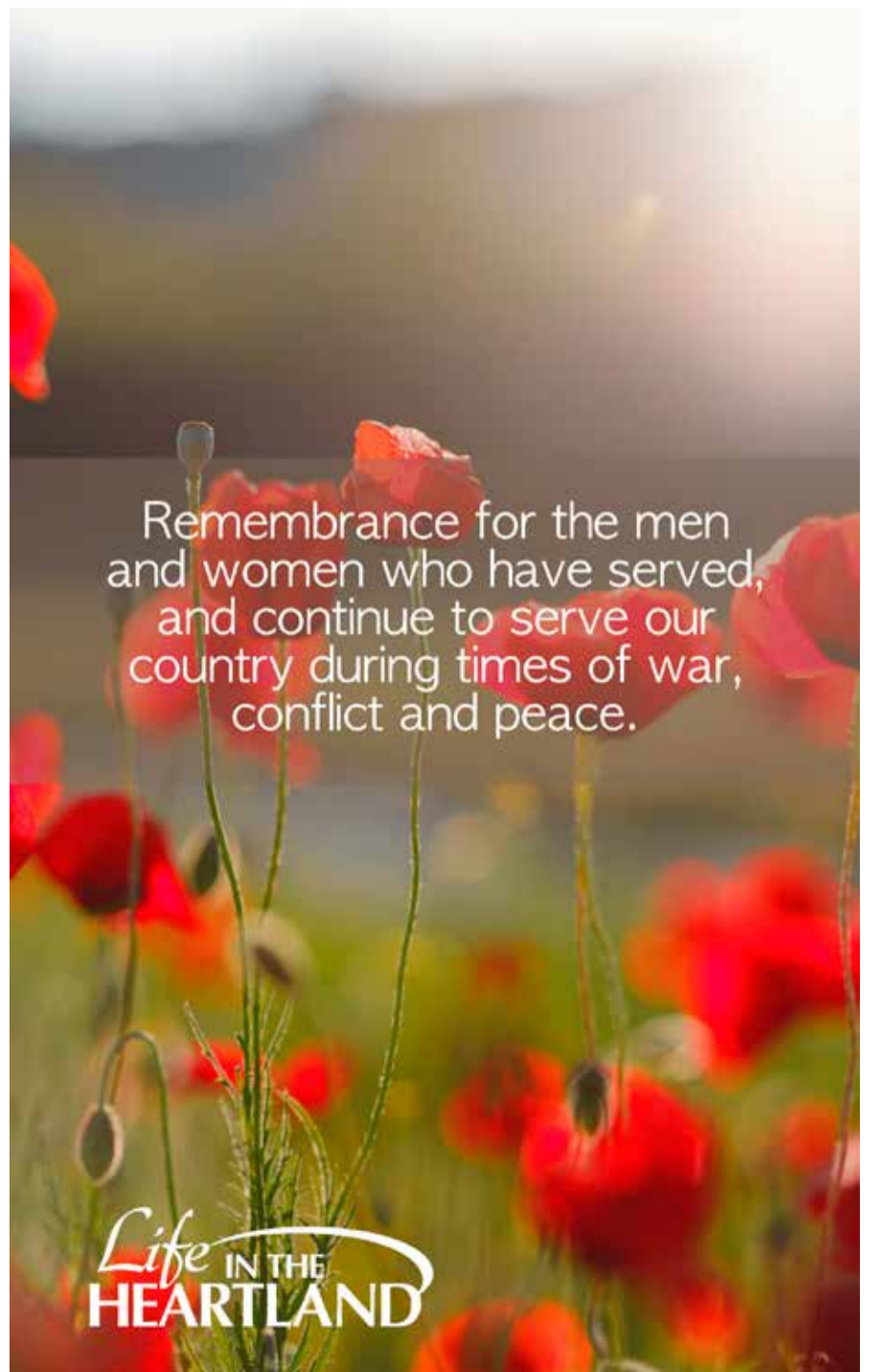
