outdoors during the cold winter months.


The evening was filled with fun and community spirit, featuring an all you can eat taco bar, margaritas, and live music by local band Calico Road.







#### **PUBLIC HEARING – Bylaw 1669/24** Amendment to Land Use Bylaw 1385/17

Sturgeon County Council requests public input on proposed Bylaw 1669/24. This Bylaw would redistrict a portion of SE-34-56-26-4 from AG -Agriculture to AG 2 - Agriculture 2 District, which accommodates diversified agricultural development with increased traffic and visitors.

The proponent is seeking to operate an Event/Wedding Venue on the property. As this land is currently designated as AG - Agriculture, it does not allow for this type of activity. Redistricting is being proposed to accommodate or allow for the associated uses.

Each time land is redistricted, a bylaw is needed to amend the Land Use Bylaw, and a Public Hearing must be held.
