

On April 1, Tanner Cst.

Wills was recognized as the Hero of the Game at game 3 of the Edmonton Oil Kings' first-round playoff series vs the Prince Albert Raiders.

Cst. Wills is the School Resource Officer at Sturgeon Composite High School and Morinville Community High School.

He received the recognition for his outstanding contributions and dedication to community service.

On April 2, members of Morinville RCMP and Sturgeon County Municipal Enforcement hosted a Coffee with a Cop event in Gibbons. This included general discussion on policing, community safety priorities and careers in law enforcement.

On the morning of April 4, Morinville RCMP, along with members of the RCMP Crime Reduction Team, arrested a suspect in possession of a 2007 Chevy Silverado in Sturgeon County north of Bon Accord.

The truck had been stolen earlier in the day from a dealership in Ponoka.

The suspect had attempted to flee from police, but the vehicle was immobilized with a spike belt, and the suspect was taken

into custody with assistance from air services.

The suspect, a 24 year old man from Morinville, was brought before a Justice of the Peace and remanded in custody to appear in St. Albert Provincial Court on April 28 to face two charges of theft, dangerous operation of a motor vehicle, possession of break-in instruments, fraudulent concealment, failing to comply with previous release conditions, six weapons-related charges, and two provincial traffic offences.

In the early morning of April 5, Morinville RCMP arrested a suspect during a late-night patrol on Highway 651 near Legal, in possession of a stolen 1996 Honda Civic.

The vehicle had been stolen the previous day from a residence in Edmonton. A 40-year-old man from Saskatoon was arrested and charged with possession of a stolen vehicle, possession of a stolen licence plate, two counts of failing to comply with previous release conditions from Saskatchewan, and five traffic related offences.

The suspect was brought before a Justice of the Peace and remanded in custody to appear in Morinville Provincial Court on April 17, where he pleaded guilty to multiple charges and was sentenced to a total of 150 days in custody.

On the evening of April 11, Morinville RCMP along with members of the RCMP Crime Reduction Team arrested a suspect driving a vehicle with a stolen licence plate in Sturgeon County between Gibbons and Redwater.

Several illegal weapons were also found in the vehicle at the time of arrest. A 39-year-old man from Vimy was arrested and charged with possession of stolen property and four weapons-related charges. He was brought before a Justice of the Peace and has been remanded in custody to appear in Morinville Provincial Court on May 8.

On the morning of April 18, Morinville RCMP responded to a shooting in the Morinville Estates Manufactured Home Community in Morinville. A 37-yearold man was found deceased at the scene. The shooting is believed to have been targeted with no risk to the general public, and the RCMP Serious Crimes Branch is investigating.

On the afternoon of April 21, Morinville RCMP responded to a two-vehicle collision on Highway 28 just north of Highway 642 in Sturgeon County.

A northbound pickup truck crossed the centre line and

collided head-on with a southbound semi-truck.

The driver of the pickup truck, a 44-year-old man from Edmonton, died at the scene, while the driver of the semi-truck was not injured.

Traffic in the area was redirected for several hours while police investigated.

Morinville student creates powerful poster for Red Dress Day

A student from Morinville Community High School is using her artistic talent to help bring awareness to a national issue.

Emma Morin has designed a powerful poster in recognition of Red Dress Day, a day that honours Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women, Girls, and Two-Spirit people (MMIWG2S).

Red Dress Day is observed annually on by the REDress Project, an art installation created in 2010 by Métis artist Jaime Black.

The installation featured empty red dresses displayed in public spaces to symbolize the lives of Indigenous women and girls who have been lost to violence or remain missing.

The school encouraged all students and community members to wear red on Monday, May 5, in solidarity.

The colour red holds special meaning in many Indigenous cultures, symbolizing the spirits of those who are missing and helping to guide them home.

With the help of young leaders like Emma and the support of schools like Morinville Community High School, the message of Red Dress Day continues to grow stronger.

PUBLIC HEARING – Bylaw 1680/25 Amendment to Land Use Bylaw 1548/21

Sturgeon County Council requests public input on proposed Bylaw #1680/25 Sturgeon Industrial Park Offsite Levy Bylaw 1548/21 Amendment.

Sturgeon County Council deems it necessary to establish Off-Site Levies to pay for the capital costs of new and expanded roads, for new or expanded water and wastewater facilities, for new or expanded stormwater facilities, and the land required in connection with those facilities, all of which will be required as a result of anticipated subdivision and development within the Sturgeon Industrial Park Area.

A bylaw is needed to amend existing bylaws, and a public hearing must be held.

Emergency response ongoing as Redwater wildfire spreads

A wildfire continues to burn in and around the Redwater Recreation Area, prompting an expanded State of Local Emergency and a region-wide response from the Sturgeon Regional Emergency Management Partnership (SREMP).

SREMP is made up of Sturgeon County, Morinville, Gibbons, Redwater, Bon Accord, and Legal.

This partnership allows the municipalities to work together by sharing resources and expertise to better prepare for and respond to emergencies.

On May 7, the emergency zone was extended east to Range Road 230 as crews continue to battle the active fire.

Dry conditions and high winds remain a serious concern. A total fire ban and off-highway vehicle (ATV/OHV) ban are in effect for Sturgeon County, Redwater,

to Legal, and Bon by Accord.

> In a strong show of community support, the Town of Morinville has stepped up in a significant way.

> The Morinville Leisure Centre (located at 25126 Secondary Highway 642) has temporarily closed to the public and is now operating as a 24-hour emergency reception centre for evacuees.

> All individuals displaced by the wildfire are required to check in at this location.

The reception centre is providing essential support and services for those impacted by the fire, demonstrating Morinville's critical role in helping the region respond to this emergency.

SREMP continues to remind residents of the importance of being ready before, during, and after emergencies.

Households should be able to care for themselves for at least 72 hours, which allows first responders to prioritize those in immediate danger.

Residents are encouraged to: • Create an emer-

gency kit with key supplies • Develop a plan for

what to do and where to go



• Prepare financially for sudden or extended disruptions

"Knowing what to do, where to go, and having the right supplies can make all the difference," said a spokesperson for SREMP. "Prepared individuals can stay safer and recover more quickly."


Review your property assessment




