Pembina renews 10-year sponsorship, extends free youth access at Morinville Leisure Centre

The Town of Morinville has renewed its long-standing partnership with Pembina Pipeline Corporation through a new 10-year sponsorship agreement that will continue to support key community programs and maintain naming rights for the Pembina Atrium at the Morinville Leisure Centre (MLC).





Morinville Mayor Simon Boersma there to help celebrate. He praised the business for its focus


on supporting local teams and building community spirit.


