Sturgeon County highlights regional fire services

Sturgeon County is helping residents gain a better understanding of the regional fire services that protect communities across the municipality.

guide released by the County provides an overview of how Sturgeon County Regional Fire Services operates, the types of emergencies fire-fighters respond to and the many ways the department works to keep residents safe.

Services responds to a wide variety of emergencies, including structure fires, grass and wildfires, motor vehicle collisions, hazardous materials incidents, rescues and other emergency situations. In addition to emergency response, firefighters

are actively involved in fire prevention, public education and emergency preparedness initiatives throughout the year.

With multiple fire stations strategically located across the county, firefighters work together to provide emergency response to communities throughout the region. Depending on the nature and location of an incident, crews from more than one station may be dispatched to ensure the appropriate personnel and equipment are available.

The information guide also introduces residents to the many responsibilities firefighters carry out beyond responding to emergencies. Ongoing training, equipment maintenance, fire inspections,

public education programs and community outreach all play an important role in maintaining a high level of emergency preparedness.

Another focus of the guide is the recruitment of paid-on-call firefighters, who provide valuable support to emergency response in many Sturgeon County communities.

Residents interested in serving their communities can learn more about the qualifications, training and commitment involved in joining the department.

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Goat yoga offers laughter, relaxation and an unexpected connection with nature

If you think yoga is always quiet and serious, Kimberly Brochu would like to change your mind. One of her favourite

memories from a goat yoga class came when a curious goat wandered over to a participant – and promptly peed on them. “Everyone burst into laughter, including the student,” Brochu recalled. “It

perfectly summed up goat yoga – you simply never know what’s going to happen.” Those lighthearted moments are part of what makes Gentle Goat Yoga at Schnitz Creek Farms a unique experience.

Brochu, owner of KB Wellness, became involved after meeting Schnitz Creek Farms owner Sandra while teaching puppy yoga.

The two quickly discovered they shared a passion for animals, wellness and bringing people together.

“We both believe in the healing power of animals, mindful movement and creating opportunities for people to connect – with themselves, each other and nature,” Brochu said.

Each class begins with breathing

exercises designed to calm the nervous system before participants move through a beginner-friendly yoga practice.

Then the goats arrive.

“They may wander between mats, cuddle up beside you, hop onto your back or simply entertain everyone with their playful personalities,” Brochu said.

While the goats provide plenty of laughs, Brochu said they also encourage people to stay present.

“Animals have an incredible ability to bring us into the present moment. They don’t judge, rush or worry – they simply exist. That energy is contagious.”

Unlike traditional yoga classes, perfection isn’t the goal.

“It’s not about

achieving the perfect pose,” she said. “It’s about experiencing joy, presence, community

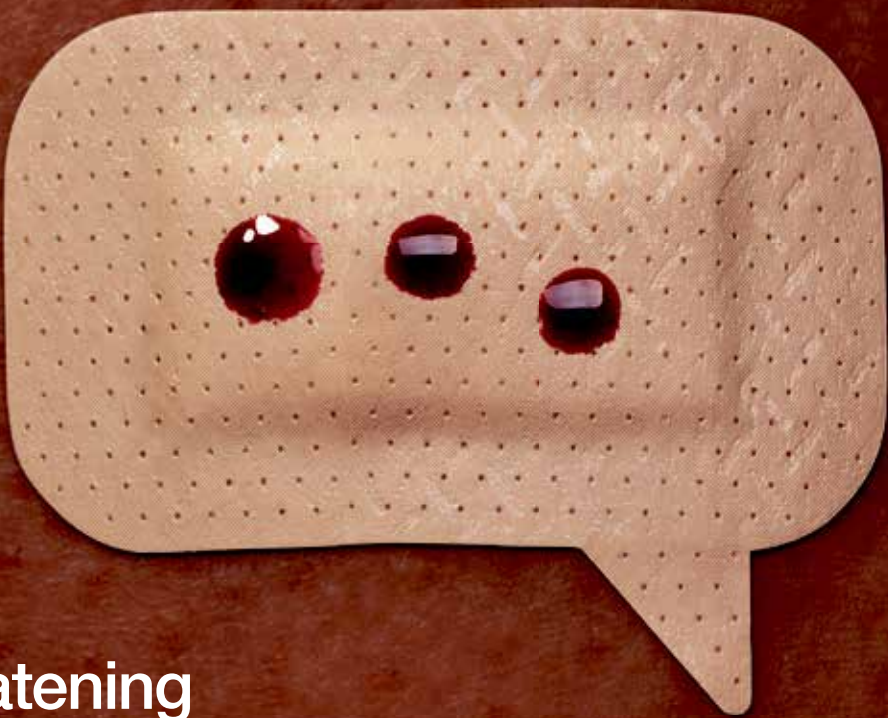
and meaningful connection.”

Morinville Free Press tries new print schedule while planning digital expansion

The Morinville Free Press is trying a new ap- proach as the newspa- per industry continues to face changes in how community papers are printed, delivered and supported.

The newspaper has moved to a hybrid mod- el, with printed editions being delivered twice per month while con- tinuing to develop its digital edition.

The change is be- ing tested to see if a twice-monthly print schedule can be a sus- tainable option while allowing the Morin- ville Free Press to con- tinue providing local coverage.

Like many community newspapers across Can- ada, the Morinville Free Press has been affected by changes in the flyer industry and the loss of traditional flyer reve- nue that helped support weekly printing and dis- tribution costs.

Over the past sever- al years, hundreds of community newspa- pers across Canada have

closed as publishers have faced rising costs, changing advertising habits and challenges within the newspaper industry.

The hybrid model will allow the newspaper to continue providing a printed edition while also preparing for an expanded digital edition planned for the fall.

The digital edition will give readers another way to access the news- paper and stay connect- ed with local stories be- tween printed editions.

Readers who want to make sure they do not miss any editions are encouraged to sign up for the Free Press Plus digital edition.

As the digital version expands, subscribers will have access to the newspaper online from anywhere. Like many community newspa- pers across Canada, we are adapting to changes within the industry.

The new print sched- ule is a trial to see if a twice-monthly newspa- per can be sustainable while we continue work- ing toward expanding

our digital edition in the fall.

The goal remains the same – continuing to provide local news and

information to Morinville and area residents.

Town Hall parking lot improvements underway in Morinville

Construction began on upgrades to the Town Hall parking lot as Morinville moved ahead with work under its 2026 Alley and Parking Lot Program.

The project included rehabilitation of the existing parking lot, surface repairs and the installation of new lighting. According to the Town, the improvements were designed to create a safer, more accessible and more functional space for

residents and visitors using the facility.

During construction, visitors to Town Hall experienced temporary disruptions, including reduced parking availability and changes to site access.

The parking lot was fully closed on Friday,

July 24, while crews completed scheduled work.

Traffic control measures and signage were in place to help guide motorists and pedestrians safely through the area.

The Town reminded residents to use caution around

construction crews and equipment and to allow additional time when visiting Town Hall during the work period.

The Town Hall parking lot project was part of Morinville's 2026 Alley and Parking Lot Program, which focused

on maintaining and improving municipal infrastructure as part of the Town's annual capital improvement work.

Residents could follow updates on this and other municipal projects through the Town of Morinville's website.
